2020 BRUT ROSÉ

TASTING NOTES

Beautifully sunset-hued, this Pinot Noir-based sparkler exudes richness and elegance. Hints of framboise and rose petals are married with brioche on the nose, meeting a lovely depth of fruit on the lush palate. Fresh strawberries and cream laced with delicate pearl bubbles flow seamlessly through to the finish.

WINEMAKER NOTES

Producing a Rosé sparkling wine requires finesse and skill to achieve the perfect hue and balance between richness and acidity. In making the 2020 Brut Rosé, a still Pinot Noir was added to the base wine right before second fermentation, which lent to its full body and lush style.

SOURCING

Sourced from Frank Family's Lewis Vineyard in Carneros. Here, the predominant maritime influence of the Pacific Ocean and San Pablo Bay creates the cool temperature, fog, and wind that make our vineyard site ideally suited for growing cool climate varieties. Lewis Vineyard consists primarily of shallow and dense clay loam soils that result in extremely low yields, producing grapes with strong character and balanced acidity.

AGING

Rested on the spent yeast cells for nearly 4 years before disgorgement in February 2025.
